Fever Fatigue Muscle Aches Vomiting Diarrhea Joint Paint Sweats/Chills Headache Bulls eye rash Loss of Appetitie Flat, Spotty Non Itchy Rash Swollen Lymph Nodes



- WEAR REPELLENT
- CHECK FOR TICKS DAILY
- SHOWER SOON AFTER BEING OUTDOORS
- CALL YOUR DOCTOR IF YOU GET A FEVER OR RASH









Did you know...

- ✓ Only black legged ticks carry Lyme Disease.
- You do not feel a tick bite because they inject an anesthetic poison that contains neurotoxins. The reaction you have from the bite is from the poison.
- ✓ Ticks can live 200 days without food or water.
- Ticks can live from 2 months to 2 years depending on the species.

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
