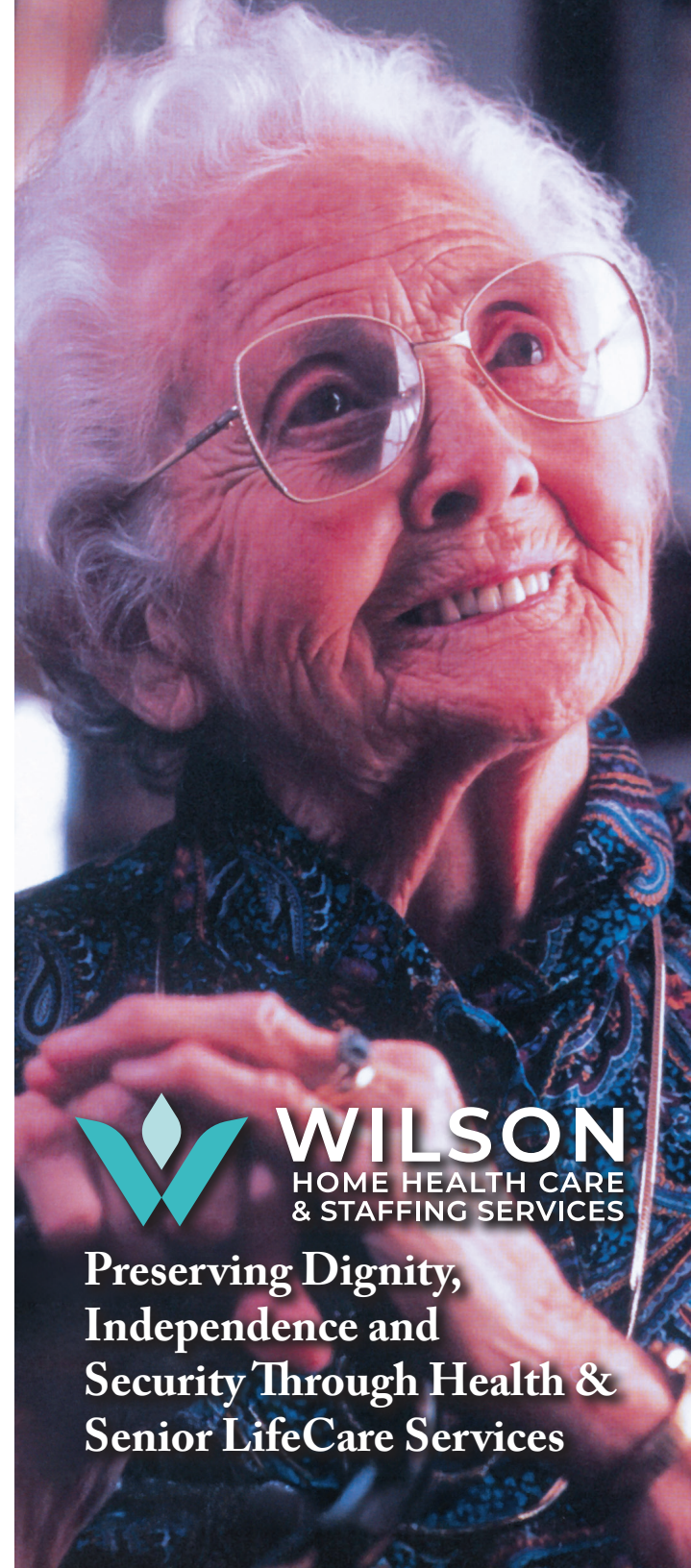

Wilson Home Health Care provides reliable, comprehensive Senior LifeCare. Services focus on case management, care coordination, and in home health caregivers when needed. Our goal is to help the Older Adult maintain as much control over his/her own life as possible by establishing trust and building strong relationships among clients, families and their professional staff.



Geriatric Care Management

A Registered Nurse care manager will conduct a caring, objective in home evaluation that focuses on the immediate challenge along with plan to minimize crisis situations in the future. The plan will be flexible and reflective of the client's personal goals and those of the family. The plan will include utilization of available resources and existing community support systems that are financially realistic. As an advocate for the client and family, the Care Manager makes regular visits to monitor the client's status and maintains contact with all service providers.



Care Coordination

Our objective is to develop and monitor a plan of intervention fostering timely communication among the client, the family and supportive professionals assisting with the LifeCare Plan. The care manager and the identified client system will maintain regular contact, open communication and an awareness of the changing needs of the client.

Home Health Caregivers

In home caregivers are selected for their education and training, work experience, reliability and sincere concern for the Older Adult. Each employee has presented credentials and references reflective of those standards. Wilson Home Health Care provides workers compensation, general liability, professional liability and bonding insurance on all employees.

Wilson Home Health Care provides prompt access to the following in home professionals 24 hours a day every day.

- **Registered Nurses and Licensed Practical Nurses.**

The services of these professionals may be required to perform treatments specific to certain medical conditions. Nurses also provide valuable family and client education.

- **Certified Home Health Aides and Companions.**

Along with offering friendship and companionship, caregivers can help with personal care, meal preparation, shopping, light housekeeping and escorting client's to doctor's appointments and social engagements. They are available on a hourly basis or live in and for respite care to relieve families taking a vacation or for those transitioning from a hospital stay.
