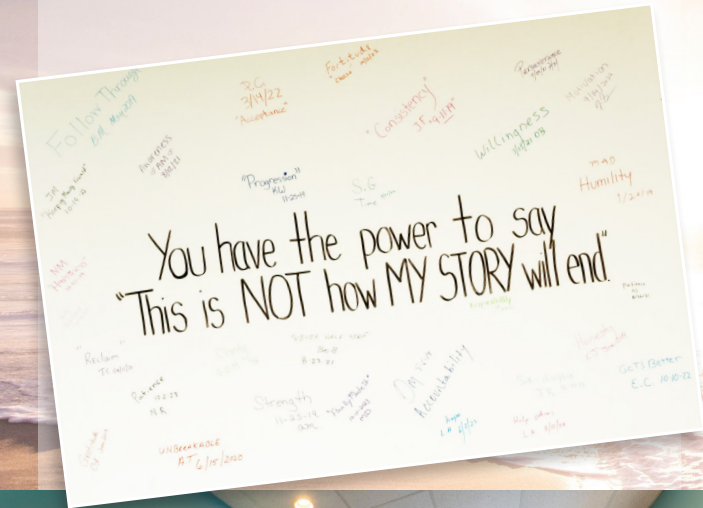

SERVICES OFFERED

RESA TREATMENT CENTER PROVIDES A FULL CONTINUUM OF CARE TO SUPPORT RECOVERY AT EVERY STAGE:

• SUBSTANCE USE EVALUATIONS

We provide professional evaluations to meet the requirements of legal systems, probation/parole, Recovery Court, IDRC, and DCP&P. Our assessments ensure compliance with agency obligations while guiding individuals toward appropriate treatment and recovery support.

• INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT (IOP) & OUTPATIENT (OP) TREATMENT

Flexible, structured programs offering counseling, group therapy, and education about addiction and mental health.

• MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)

Evidence-based care combining FDA-approved medications with counseling to manage cravings, reduce withdrawal symptoms, and support lasting recovery. Medications offered include Naltrexone, Vivitrol (monthly injectable naltrexone), Buprenorphine [Suboxone/Subutex].

WHAT WE TREAT

WE PROVIDE TREATMENT FOR:

• SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS:

Including alcohol, opioids, and other addictive substances.

• CO-OCCURRING DISORDERS:

Substance use disorders with co-existing mental health conditions such as depression, anxiety, mood disorders, personality disorders, or other trauma-related symptoms.

Please Note: To be eligible for treatment, individuals must have a primary diagnosis of a substance use disorder.
