LOCAL HISTORY COLLECTION

The Local History Collection was created to collect, maintain, and preserve materials on local history for historians and library patrons. In our collection, we have:

- Old books and yearbooks
- Maps, photos, postcards
- Materials from the Red Bank area dating back well into the 19th century.
- Vertical files of periodical clippings primarily about Red Bank and the surrounding shore area
