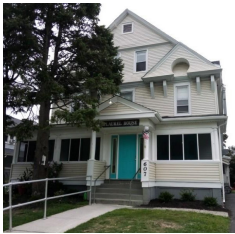
PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Congregate Living

HABcore owns two large homes that house 21 people in Red Bank and 30 people in Asbury Park. We offer a comfortable atmosphere with 24-hour supervision. HABcore's supportive housing model provides:

- Three Nutritious Meals a Day
- Medication Monitoring
- Laundry Facilities
- Behavior Modification
- Life Skills Training
- Enrichment Activities

HABcore does not receive any government funding for its congregate living homes.

Our congregate living homes have been the cornerstone of our mission since HABcore's inception in 1988.

Independence Pathways

We combine affordable housing with a holistic supportive service program to assist individuals and families, the majority of whom are struggling with chronic physical and mental health issues.

Individualized support enables formerly homeless residents to reach personal stability and achieve their goals. This program includes:

- Wrap Around Case Management
- Financial Literacy
- Supported Employment
- Life Skills Training
- Symptom Management
- Community Engagement
- Wellness Education and Recreation
- Parenting and Communication Skills

Strengthening Families

Parents can participate in more intensive services focusing on healthy lifestyles, as well as parenting and life skills to further promote their independence.



Street Outreach in Ocean County

Our Ocean County team focuses on the most urgent needs of unsheltered individuals and people facing eviction. The team provides:

- Removing barriers to housing and connecting to housing opportunities
- Immediate safety needs
 - Transportation to safety net services
 - Food, water, blankets
- Referrals to other social services
- Homelessness diversion
 - Financial assistance to keep people from entering homelessness when funding is available
