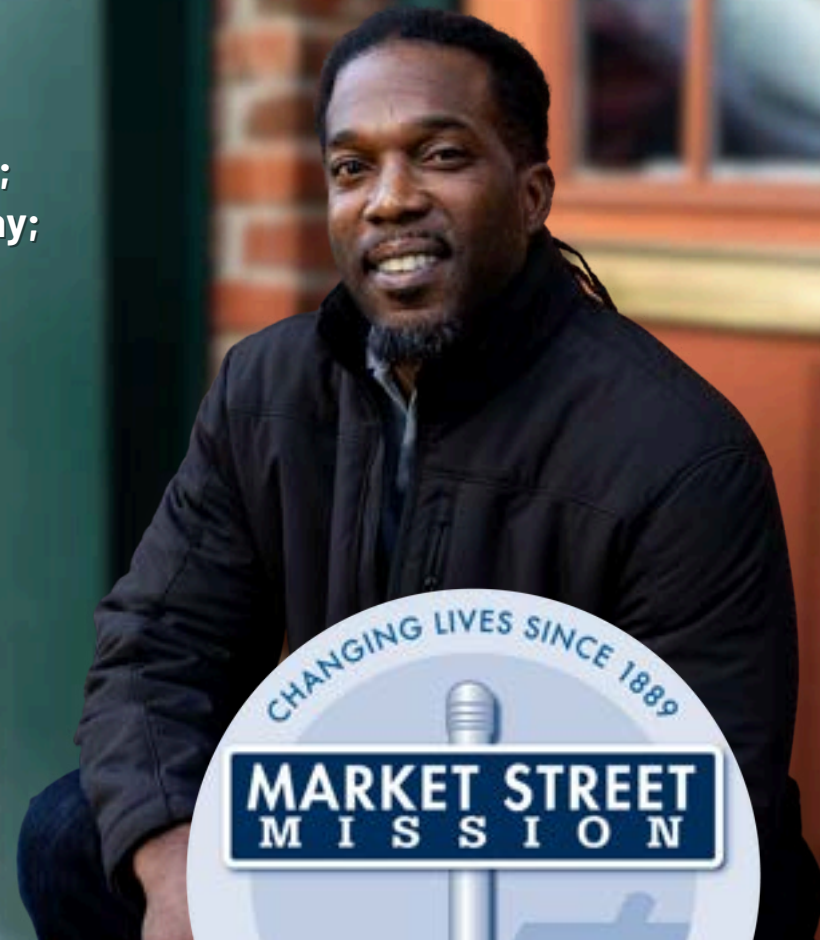
Our clients spend seven to ten months in a holistic treatment setting designed to address the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual factors that influence drug and alcohol dependence.

Our Christ-centered rehabilitation program incorporates daily spiritual development, 12-step fellowship, individual and group counseling, family therapy, classroom instruction, and job skills training to prepare our clients to live sober and productive lives. The program consists of three phases leading to graduation and transitional housing.

ADDICTION RECOVERY PROGRAM FOR MEN

Serving Throughout New Jersey
with locations in Morristown, Asbury Park and Newton

The Market Street Mission cares for immediate needs today AND long-term needs for a stable, independent tomorrow.

PRE-PROGRAM

Our program begins with a 30-day assessment period where both the client and the Mission determine if our program is the right fit.

PHASE 1: WORK THERAPY

The client is assigned a job at the Mission, developing life skills like a strong work ethic while attending counseling, Bible study, and recovery meetings. We also assess his educational needs in our Career Education Center.

PHASE 2: CLASSROOM PHASE

The client attends classes to build essential life skills for transitioning from the Mission into society. Topics include Anger Management, Fatherhood & Manhood, Christian Doctrine, Christian Finance, Relapse Prevention and Career Employment Skills.

GRADUATION & BEYOND

After completing our program, graduates can stay at our facility for three months free, allowing them to secure a job, save money and plan their next steps.



ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

SOBER LIVING HOUSES

Market Street Mission owns sober living houses in Morris and Monmouth County for program alumni. Residents pay reduced rent, maintain sobriety and uphold daily accountability.

RESTORATION & RENEWAL PROGRAM

Aimed to help graduates who relapse into substance abuse or homelessness, this three month program includes counseling, 12-step sponsorship, and a transition phase with work and savings opportunities. Successful participants may stay up to three additional months.
