DCF Staff Understanding Adult Medicaid

Adult Medicaid is required for youth to receive:

- Services from the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD)
- To apply for a NJ State appointed guardian through the Bureau of Guardianship Services (BGS)

Examples of Adult Medicaid Eligibility

SSI

 The Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program provides monthly payments to adults and children with a disability or blindness who have income and resources.

ABD Medicaid

- The NJ FamilyCare Aged, Blind, Disabled (ABD) Programs are multiple programs for people who need access to health care services in the community, or in long-term care facilities.

- New Jersey residents may qualify for individual coverage through NJ FamilyCare based on income.
- The individual does not have severe developmental disabilities.

CP&P staff must ensure that an SSI application is submitted to the Social Security Administration on behalf of all CP&P youth with developmental disabilities (DD) who are potentially eligible for SSI by following the procedures set forth in <u>CP&P Policy - Federal Benefits 1X-F-1-250.</u>



To ensure that a timely application is filed on behalf of potentially eligible youth with DD, the CP&P caseworker must notify the local office Title IV-E Liaison:

- When a youth on his/her/their caseload with DD is residentially placed
- 90 days before the 18th birthday of a youth with DD on his/her/their caseload

The Local Office Title IV-E Liaison should complete the SSI application and forward to the ORFR&IV-EO regardless of the youth's eligibility for Title IV-E benefits because a Title IV-E eligible youth may be found eligible and not payable for SSI.
