Medicaid, State/ County Funding (for those who qualify), DUII, DCPP, Drug Court, CCG, WFNJ, MAP, ISP & Private Insurance

Adolescent Inpatient Services

County and Children's System of Care (CSOC) Funding-NO COST to families in New Jersey

Adolescent Withdrawal Management:

- Safe, Medical Monitoring of withdrawal symptoms in adolescent from drug of dependence
- Higher success rate of adolescent staying for treatment. Longer treatment increases the likelihood for sustained abstinence.

Short-Term Residential (STR)

- ASAM Level 3.7 (Medically Monitored Intensive Inpatient Treatment)
- Average length of stay: 2-3 months
- Only withdrawal management for adolescents in the state
- Establishing and Setting Treatment Goals, Individual and group therapy
- 13-18 year olds who have not completed their education
- Medication Monitoring
- On site Psychiatrist
- Multiple Allied Therapies
- Family Program/Education 2x a Week
- On site schooling through MOSC
- Medical assistance for co-occurring disorder
- Treatment of Co-occurring Disorders
- A sober discharge plan-Aftercare, IOP, in-home, etc.
